

The Following Items ARE ALLOWED for Spring Pick UP:

- Large appliances: stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers, water heaters, water softeners, microwaves. For freezers and refrigerators, the compressors must be removed. Freon must be removed and have tag from certified technician.
  - Large furniture: couches, chairs, tables, mattresses, bed frames, dressers, lamps, end tables, etc.
  - Any item such as carpet and padding must be cut into pieces under 6 ft, tied and/or bound.
- NO LOOSE ITEMS THROWN AT THE CURB. Any loose items must be bagged, bound, or tied for easy handling. If not contained properly, loose items will be left.
  - Will take any bagged trash, paper, cans, small misc items considered household junk.
    - Dry paint cans with the lids off.
  - All mattresses or furniture containing fabric must be wrapped in plastic.

The Following Items ARE NOT ALLOWED for Spring Pick UP:

- Construction materials from a business, building, or home: shingles, wood, panel doors, windows, siding, bricks, cement, concrete, drywall, any type of remodeling material.
  - Rocks, grass, dirt, tree branches and trunks, leaves, bushes, any type of yard waste.
  - Wet paint, oil, gas, medical waste, whole tires, auto parts (bumpers, seats, fenders, etc)
    - No messy liquids of any type that could be considered hazardous.
    - No burn barrels or their ashes will be taken.
- NO ELECTRONICS: TV's, computers and their accessories, stereos, etc. These items can be taken to Oscar Winski in Lafayette, Best Buy, or Office Depot Stores.
